Student Account

FFAA – Demographic Information

The Demographic Information section of the FFAA has two parts – the information from the Profile and an ‘Other Information’ section. The Demographic section will be prepopulated with the information submitted on the Profile. Any changes that need to be made to the demographic information must be done on the Profile, by selecting the “Click Here” link.

FFAA – Academic Background

The 'Academic Background' tab includes questions about the student's current high school status and their future postsecondary plans.

Students are no longer asked about ACT, SAT test taking plans or estimated high school GPA. In addition the 'student type' question is being replaced with a YES/NO question related to earning a bachelor's degree.
